## **UPDATE to COVID-19 entry questionnaire**

Effective next Monday, September 14, 2020 you will notice an update to the COVID-19 Entry Questions.

Please continue to keep the following in mind:

- Pay attention and be aware of any new symptoms and error on the side of caution.
- If you have any of the symptoms listed, go to medical – even if you think your symptoms might be allergies.
- Remember: Be aware of who you have had contact with and if they have tested positive.
- If you have taken a COVID-19 test, we want to know – medical will assess your situation and determine whether or not you will be permitted to enter.

It is on all of us to have an IT'S ON ME attitude as we work to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

**Air Travel and Cruises** 

The travel question has been eliminated. Following COVID-19 Protocols and being aware of symptoms remains important while traveling.


