Tornado Safety

Tornadoes are violent: they can completely destroy well-made structures, uproot trees and hurl objects through the air like deadly missiles. Although severe tornadoes are most common in the Plains States, they can happen anywhere. Learn what to do to keep your loved ones safe.

Top Tips

- Identify a safe place in your home where household members and pets will gather during a tornado: a basement, storm cellar or an interior room on the lowest floor with no windows.
- In a high-rise building, pick a hallway in the center of the building. You may not have enough time to go to the lowest floor.
- In a mobile home, choose a safe place in a nearby sturdy building. If your mobile home park has a designated shelter, make it your safe place. No mobile home, however it is configured, is safe in a tornado.

• Know the difference!

A tornado **WATCH** means a tornado is possible.

A tornado **WARNING** means a tornado is already occurring or will occur soon. GO TO YOUR SAFE PLACE IMMEDIATELY.

Prepare in Advance

- · Assemble an emergency preparedness kit.
- Create a household evacuation plan that includes your pets.

How to Prepare for Tornadoes:

Protecting your family

- Talk about tornadoes with your family so that everyone knows where to go if a tornado warning is issued.
- · Know your workplace tornado emergency plans.

Sign Up for Notifications

Know how your community sends warnings. Some communities have outdoor sirens. Others depend on media and smart phones to alert residents of severe storms capable of producing tornadoes. *Lucas County Alerts*, where our facility (TTO) is located, is a free service provided by Lucas County. In the event of an emergency or tornado warning, an alert will be sent to the phone number(s) you provide and/or your email address. Sign up at: http://www.lucascountyalerts.com/ This site also alerts you to other weather related events such as Snow Level emergencies.

Don't wait until you see the tornado to act! Move to an underground shelter, basement or safe room. If none is available, a small, windowless interior room or hallway on the lowest level of a sturdy building is the safest alternative.

Being prepared is the best protection. Listen to broadcasts and having an emergency preparedness kit will go a long way in protecting you and your family in the event a tornado is headed your way.
