

TTO Shifts into High Gear

TTO is launching its second new product program in six months — an impressive feat! The new programs have allowed our plant, which is already one of GM's largest Global Propulsion Systems facilities, to expand by more than 550,000 square feet.

Two years ago, TTO announced a significant investment in its future: \$667.6 million for two future product programs. The first program, the Global Front Wheel Drive nine-speed transmission, was announced in the fall of 2018 and supports Lansing Delta Township production of the Buick Enclave and Chevrolet Traverse.

Recently, the plant began production of a 10-speed transmission for the new 2020 Chevrolet Silverado HD produced at Flint Assembly.

During launch preparation and ramp up, the plant faced significant hurdles, including numerous small car scheduling adjustments, six-speed transmission buildout and associated employee movement within the facility to support the new 9-speed and 10-speed programs.

Jeff King, chairman, UAW Local 14, recognized Toledo Transmission team members for their hard work. "I commend the entire workforce for their efforts over the past two years and for what they do every day – building high quality transmissions. Thank you for your commitment, your efforts to continuously improve, and your focus on customer satisfaction. The joint leadership team is extremely proud of you. Thank you for all you do."

TTO has a long-standing reputation of quality, productivity and performance. The plant was one of the first plants in North America, and globally to achieve Global Manufacturing System BIQ Level IV certification – an achievement to ensure everything we do is driven by the customer.


