Leadership Changes and Ventilator Update

On August 11, GM announced John Stapleton, GM North America Chief Financial Officer, has been named acting global Chief Financial Officer. The appointment follows the resignation of Dhivya Suryadevara, executive vice president and CFO, who has left the company for an opportunity outside of the automotive industry.

GM also announced August 11 that, after it completes the Federal government's order for 30,000 critical care ventilators by end of August, it will hand off operational control to Ventec to continue manufacturing operations in Kokomo, Indiana. To date, the partnership has delivered more than 20,000 critical care ventilators to the Strategic National Stockpile for the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.

As a result of the 2019 National Negotiations, employees who hold Skilled Trades credentials and are Working in a production assignment are eligible to complete the attached application. This application allows them to indicate which Skilled Trade groups they are willing to be placed in or retrained in, and the locations they would be interested in relocating to. When skilled job openings cannot be filled with a matching trade member, the National Parties may offer a retraining position to an employee, who has applied to that skilled group and location.

Other placement opportunities, in accordance with the National Agreement, may also be offered. Those eligible employees who submit the attached application will be given no more than two retraining offers. If those offers are refused, or they fail to submit the application to their respective employment office, their future skilled placement options will be made pursuant to the provisions of Appendix A of the 2019 UAW-GM National Agreement.

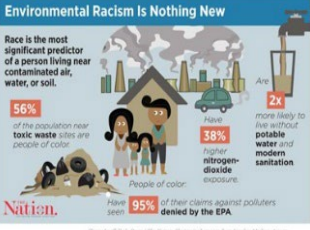
