Please register no later than April 15, 2019.

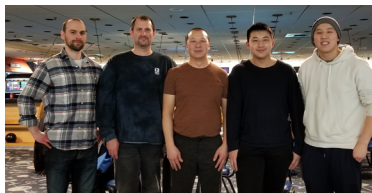
