Weed Eater Safety

With warmer weather approaching, it will soon be time to get the weed eater out. Taking precautions while using all power tools is very important. Careful operation and following these safety tips will minimize the chances of injury when using a weed eater.

- 1) Wear solid shoes to protect your feet.
- 2) Wear long pants to protect your legs.
- 3) Wear work gloves to protect your hands.
- 4) Wear eye protection to protect your eyes from flying debris.
- 5) Make sure all guards are in place.
- 6) Be aware of your surroundings when next to roads and other sources of activity.
- 7) Stop cutting if someone approaches within 50 feet to avoid hitting them with flying debris.
- 8) Keep the weed eater below knee height.
- 9) Stop the engine and disconnect the spark plug when making repairs.
- 10) Use the correct fuel mixture.
- 11) Allow the engine to cool before refueling.

Creating a New User Account Is Quick & Easy

- Click new user
- Complete the personal information section of the registration page and click next
- Enter a unique username and password
- Select a security question and answer and click submit
- After registration, you will receive a confirmation email containing your registration information

CALL-IN PROCEDURE

TTO Hourly Labor has received request for the correct procedure to report an absence or late call-in and have asked this to be posted. This info can also be found on page 9-2 of the Local Agreement.

Call-In Procedure

- Must call if absence is not previously arranged
- Call: 1-800-222-8889 or 419-470-5000 (Only if the 1-800 number is not available) Call MUST be completed at least 30 minutes prior to the start of shift.
- For FMLA Absence: You must call both the 1-800 number above AND 1-800-489-4646 (National Benefits Center) Both calls MUST be completed at least 30 minutes prior to the start of shift.
- 24 hours - 7 days/week
- Get call-in sequence number
- Be prepared to give:
 - ✓ Name
 - ✓ Department
 - ✓ GMIN number
 - ✓ Reason
 - ✓ Expected duration
 - ✓ Phone
