Spring is just around the corner! The first day of spring is March 20, and spring is a great time to review your home safety checklist. The National Safety Council recommends the following safety checks for your home.

1. Smoke Alarms

Smoke alarms save lives – if they are powered by a fresh battery. You should test them every month to make sure they work and replace the battery at least once a year, according to the National Fire Protection Association. If the alarm makes a "chirping" sound, replace it immediately.

2. Carbon Monoxide Detectors

Carbon monoxide (CO) is an invisible, odorless gas, and it can kill you. The safety tips for CO detectors mirror those of smoke alarms: change the batteries, test them and interconnect them, if possible.

3. Family Emergency Plan

The National Safety Council recommends every family have an emergency plan in place in the event of a natural disaster or other catastrophic event. Spring is a great time to review that plan with family members to make sure they know what to do.

The NSC also recommends you take unwanted or expired medicines to a prescription drop box or take-back event near you, update your first-aid kit and, most of all, get outside and have fun!
