New Corvette ZR1 Amazes Media at Road Atlanta

Last November Chevrolet introduced the 2019 ZR1, the fastest production Corvette ever. Advancing Corvette's performance legacy, the ZR1 supercar features the most power,



greatest track performance and most advanced technology in Corvette's 66-year history.

Just five months later, the media got the opportunity to test the ZR1 for the first time at Road Atlanta, one of America's most famous and challenging road courses. Mark Reuss, executive vice president, Global Product Development, Purchasing and Supply Chain, was on hand to meet with media and take the ZR1 for some hot laps around Road Atlanta's 2.54-mile circuit.

"I've never driven a Corvette like this before," said Reuss. "Its unprecedented performance puts all other global supercars on notice that the ZR1 is back." (Pictured above)

Mark is a Corvette owner and a lifelong performance vehicle enthusiast. He joined the media group to discuss the 2019 Corvette ZR1's engineering and development process and put the car's exclusive LT5 supercharged engine through its paces on the track.

"General Motors and our engineers who integrate, design and build these vehicles are better than anyone in the world," Reuss said after testing the vehicle. "They deserve to feel really good because they've worked hard for years to get this car out there and I couldn't be prouder of them."
