TTO and UAW Local 14 Veterans Wall Dedication

On Tuesday, May 28, 2019, Toledo Transmission Operations hosted Ken Barrett, Global Chief Diversity Officer and Tonya Hallett, Executive Director, Global Manufacturing Human Resources. The visit included meeting with military veterans and an informal floor walk and employee interaction.

During the Veterans Wall ceremony Ken Barrett (retired Navy Captain) recognized the sacrifice of our veterans. Ken also noted the service of GM and the UAW during WWII and that President Franklin D. Roosevelt calling the auto industry and specifically this part of the country the "Arsenal of Democracy" for the impact we provided through trucks, tanks, planes, weapons, engines, propellers and artillery shells. "In fact, Toledo Transmission was critical to the war effort, GM produced more than 850,000 trucks, almost all of them using Toledo parts," stated Barrett.

The event began with the playing of the National Anthem and followed with a benediction by Local 14 Chaplain Randy Pitney and statements from Eric Gonzales, Plant Executive Director, Denny Earl, UAW Local 14 President and Veterans Committee Chairperson Peggy McKnight-Wilson.

Matthew Boaz, the City of Toledo Diversity and Inclusion Director and Tyrome Alexander, City of Toledo Human Resources Director were also guests for the ceremony.

Each veteran had their names placed on the wall and received an American flag and a ceremonial coin.
