Looking at our Safety Trends during Global Safety Week

With safety week upon us, I wanted to express my sincere gratitude to everyone who has embraced GM's safety vision:

"Live values that return people home safely. Every person. Every site. Every day."

As you know, we've been working diligently over the last several years on building a 24/7 focus on safety. I am proud to share some of our key safety accomplishments:



• We have developed a Global Workplace Safety comprehensive strategy that brings us closer to our vision for the future of zero injuries.

• We established a global standard for PPE to eliminate many of the most common workplace injuries.

• Since 2016, we have seen a 1/3 reduction in Lost Work Day Case and Recordable Injury Rates and a 30% reduction in total Incident Rate.

• In 2018, GM launched a new Safety Analytics Dashboard to access global performance data for analysis, replacing a patchwork of disconnected data collection systems.

• Last year, more than 40,000 people were trained in hazard recognition and over 10,000 leaders were trained in GM's risk assessment tools.

We can only build the safer, stronger GM of tomorrow by making a personal commitment to living our safety values and vision today. Together, we are building a stronger future for GM.
