In an effort to be consistent, transparent, and timely, I would like to take the opportunity to provide an update on our upcoming production schedule.

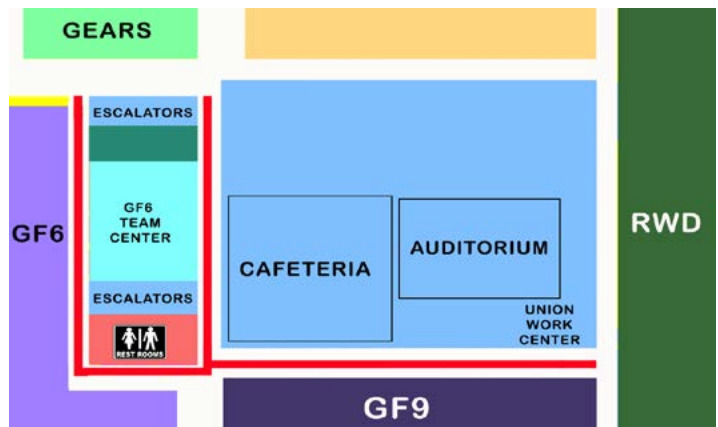
There has been a change to our previously announced production schedule affecting timing of GF6 build out at TTO. In June, we announced that GF6 production at TTO would be discontinued by the end of 2018. However, due to scheduling changes, GF6 production at TTO will be extended through the second quarter of 2019. This extension, along with other scheduling changes, will require us to accelerate previously communicated plans, which include updated layoff impact, recall numbers and dates. Although timing has changed, the GF6 program will be discontinued at TTO as planned.

It is important to note that the GF6 timing change does not affect preparation for future product programs. Ongoing work, planning activities and timing will proceed as previously communicated.

Additional information will be shared with team members as soon as it is available.

Safety Glass Free Zone



Red lines indicate areas of safety glass free zone

Effective immediately the covered areas on the red outline on the map are **safety glass free**.

The safety glass free zone runs from the north escalator south to the entrance for GF6, east through the covered aisle toward the Union Work Center. Also included is the aisle between the GF6 team center and cafeteria, from the Level 1 BPD board south to the entrance to GF9 and the covered aisle.

Sorbites...Our Re-Washable

Absorbent Pads

Please return them after
use to the soiled Sorbites
plastic drums



Absorbtech Sorbites are the re-washable absorbent pads here at the plant. To make sure that we have a substantial amount of Sorbites to go around, we need to make sure that the soiled ones are being returned to us in a timely manner. One way to make that happen is when you use the Sorbites for a spill, once the spill has been fully cleaned, put all of the Soiled Sorbites in the blue Soiled Sorbites plastic drum. Another way, is by picking up any Soiled Sorbites we see laying on the ground throughout the week and placing them in the blue Soiled Sorbites plastic drum. The Sorbites are a great way to steer away and reduce our single-use absorbent pads that we have been using for previous years.
