- **New face masks.** In the following weeks we'll be receiving a new batch of face masks from GM Warren, MI. The only difference is the color, they will be white (as the first batch we receive before the blue ones)
These new GM masks, provide the same protection like the ones we provide you on a daily basis while entering the plant.
- **Walking and eating/drinking.**
Can employees remove their mask to eat or drink while walking inside the facility?
No. When eating or drinking, remain stationary and maintain 6ft physical distancing.
- **GM Global Social Distancing Guidance for work related Vehicle Use.** Being in a small enclosed environment like a two row passenger vehicle creates a risk for disease transmission. The safest way to travel is one person per vehicle and is the preferred method of travel. Some company operations require more than one person to occupy a vehicle for testing or evaluation and specific task instructions have been created. Requirements for two people in a vehicle include wearing of a standard GM supplied mask for short duration trips (<30 minutes) and use of an N95 mask for longer periods of time (>30 minutes). Eating, drinking, or other activities where a mask might have to be lowered are prohibited. Also, to facilitate fresh air flow, do not use the RECIRC feature on the HVAC system. Director approval is required when more than two people will be required to be in a passenger vehicle, this should be avoided if possible.

- **Brush their teeth at work.**
Can employees brush their teeth at work?
Brushing teeth is acceptable in our restrooms, but in no other place. Physical distancing is critical while brushing teeth as the mask will be removed.
