Pre-Strike Information

Brothers and Sisters,

There has never been such a heightened awareness and expectation for a strike like this in many decades. This has created many questions and uneasiness with what lies ahead of us. We've been through this before, so we know what to expect. In 2019 we had the best run strike in GM and that was because of you. We look to repeat our performance if called to do so.

Our Strike Captains will be our elected and appointed representatives. If a strike is called, we will have a meeting at the union hall at 2pm and 5:30 pm on Thursday, September 14th for these Strike Captains. Unfortunately, at this time, the International Union has not let us know who our UAW Strike Liaison assigned to our local will be. This makes it difficult to identify what days our strike benefit sign-up period will be. The International Union does not allow members to sign up for strike benefits until an actual strike is called. We will have more letters with up-to-date information as we receive directions from the International Union. To make communication easier, we have added a STRIKE section at the uawlocal14.org website. Please visit it often.

Credentials that you need for sign up are the following:

Your Legal Name, Address, Telephone Number

A working email address. Please before you show up to register make sure you have a working email address with the up to date password.

Banking Information. Please bring the bank account routing number and the account number you want your strike pay deposited in.

Social Security Number.

List of dependents and their following:

Social Security Number, Birth Dates, and Insurance information.

Insurance Information. Group Life insurance and Medical-Hospitalization

Strike assignments will be for one six-hour shift per week. This is different from the last strike which was two days. We listened to the membership and adjusted the required strike assignment. Some members live long distances away and this will lessen their burden during a stressful time. Your Strike Captain is responsible for reporting your participation. This participation is how you get paid. The International has a new process that we must follow. It is stricter and less forgiving for members that miss assignments.

We have informed the International Union on two different occasions that our members want a paper check option. Both times they have denied our request. We are not alone, we talked to other locals that feel the same way. We will continue to let them know our members' desires.
